Carolyn Jones Burns, age 87 of 245 Hales Drive, Anderson S.C. entered eternal life on Wednesday, December 6, 2023, at the Callie and John Rainey Hospice House. She was a native of Marion Indiana and was born September 13, 1936, to the late Thomas Jones and Thelma Davis Jones.

She was a graduate of Chrispus Attucks High School in Indiana. She lived the greatest part of her life in Indiana where she met and married her husband the late Reverend Paul Sylvester Burns.
