Howard “Bud” Weldon Flier II, born January 2, 1943, in St. Louis, Missouri, and raised in the Lake of the Ozarks, passed away on February 14, 2026.

Bud served his country in the United States Navy for three years aboard the USS Lexington. Throughout his working life, he was employed as a motion picture operator and later as an owner-operator over-the-road truck driver. He was a proud member of the Teamsters.

He enjoyed supporting the Silver-Haired Legislature and was active in political causes important to him. Bud was a member of North Anderson Community Church Presbyterian, an inclusive faith community that values questions and the journey toward answers.

He was known for his generosity and his commitment to justice. Bud was a friend of Bill W. for 45 years. Despite becoming disabled and wheelchair-bound later in life, he continued to plan for the future and was recently shopping for a new car and a three-wheeled motorcycle.

He will be deeply missed by Amy and Dan Knapp; Marcy and Don Robinson; and Trudy Hyder and Tim Wilson; his 11 grandchildren; and 2 great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his wife, Linda, to whom he was married for over 51 years. A celebration of life will be held on March 7th at
