



## Mr. Roy "TC" Davis

Roy "TC" Davis, age 72, of 1007 South Manning St. passed Friday at the AnMed Medical Center. He was born in Anderson County and was the son of the late Sybil Scott and Roy Davis. 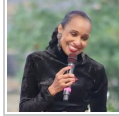
